

Oxford chamber choir JUBILATE! introduce choral music to local school children through BBC Ten Pieces Project with support of The Exuberant Trust

The [BBC Ten Pieces initiative](#) is designed to inspire creativity and a love of music in school children. The BBC provides a recording (visual and audio) of ten wonderful pieces of music to be screened free of charge for school children. BBC Ten Pieces Champions then build on this experience with local events.

Oxford chamber choir JUBILATE! is a Ten Pieces Champion, and in October 2015 the choir gave two short concerts in St. Nicholas Church Islip and Pegasus School in Blackbird Leys. The music was wide ranging and accessible, including Handel's thrilling Coronation Anthem 'Zadok the Priest' and Fauré's soaring 'In Paradisum'. Children from Beckley Church of England Primary School and the three Blackbird Academy Trust schools including Pegasus participated in two of the pieces, including 'My Guardian Angel' by Master of the Queen's Music Judith Weir, www.judithweir.com and Howard Goodall's ever popular theme tune from 'The Vicar of Dibley'.

Following on from the enthusiasm generated by these events local Oxfordshire arts charity The Exuberant Trust is delighted to support the attendance of some of the children and their teachers involved at the choir's immensely popular annual Christmas Concert held in the richly atmospheric surroundings of Keble College Chapel. This year's sold-out edition entitled *Hodie Christus Natus Est* will take place on Thursday 17th December. The children will have the chance to hear the choir with accompaniment from the chapel's magnificent new organ, as well as to meet Judith Weir, and to join the choir in singing 'My Guardian Angel'.

JUBILATE! is a mixed-voice chamber choir of around 35 voices based in Oxford, UK. This year the choir has celebrated 20 years of JUBILATE! and was delighted to welcome [Benjamin Nicholas](#) as their new director from September 2015. The choir gives three main concerts a year in Oxford, performing a wide range of music spanning from the Renaissance to the present day, and hosts occasional singing days in local churches.
